

BANK HOUSE FLY FISHERY



The trout at Bank House are everywhere and a network of tree-lined islands, pools and swims allows the angler to fish in privacy. It is also a haven for wildlife. Kingfishers and nuthatches are amongst numerous resident species and under the water it is rich in aquatic insect life.

Tigers and browns spend much of their time lying close to the lake bed looking up at the surface. This means that dry flies are a good way to target them. Rainbows can often be found foraging tight into the islands. Buzzers and nymphs fished slowly on floating line will always prove productive. The blue trout are acrobatic and hard fighting and there are plenty of big specimens so don't fish too lightly!

DIRECTIONS TO STOCKS

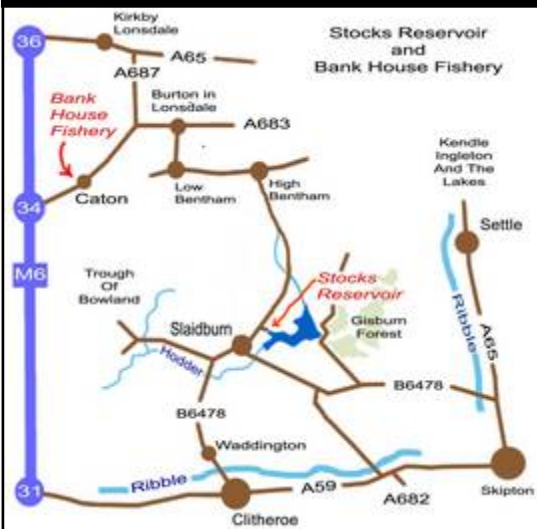
From M6 Junction 31: A59 to Clitheroe. In Clitheroe take the B6478 to Waddington continue over the fell to Newton. Turn right at T junction, to Slaidburn follow road sharply right, turn left at war memorial. Stocks is 2 miles on the right

From M6 Junction 36: A65 past Kirkby Lonsdale turn right to Burton in Lonsdale. At 'B in L' turn right at T Junction. 400m Turn left to Low Bentham. At 'L.B' turn left to High Bentham on Main St. turn right to Slaidburn. Stocks 10 miles over fell on the left.

From Skipton (A65): A59 to Gisburn. Through Gisburn turn right by cattle market. (1m) turn left, through Bolton by Bowland, over crossroads then 1st left. (2m) turn right at TJ. (2m) turn right at TJ then left at TJ to Slaidburn. Turn right at war memorial. Stocks 2m on right.

DIRECTIONS TO BANK HOUSE FLY FISHERY

M6 junction 34. Take the A683 to Caton for 2 miles. Turn left at the speed camera into the landscaped entrance to Low Mill. Go under the bridge, turn First left to the fishery car-park. Bank House Fly Fishery is across the lane.

Spanning 360 acres and with 4.5 miles of fishable shoreline Stocks has a wild and unspoiled quality. It is extremely well stocked with triploid Rainbows, Browns and Blues reared in our own farms. The fishery is initially stocked with 5000 trout in Feb & March and then twice weekly throughout the rest of the season. The trout range from 2lbs to over 20lbs and Stocks has earned a reputation for its massive quality fish. Stocks lends itself very well to both drifting boat anglers and wandering bank anglers. Drifting the margins is a superb strategy for the early and late season when hungry trout cruise the shallows feeding on aquatic insects and mountain minnows. An abundance of terrestrial insects throughout late spring and summer produces unrivaled top of the water sport. Stocks is open from the last Saturday in February to the end of November. A friendly member of staff is always on duty to offer you advice and our lodge with café and toilets is open all day.
